- I. The meeting convened 7:00 PM. Welcome Kevin Chamberlain!
- II. The minutes of the May 15 meeting were approved.
- III. Financial Report Payment for Nora's bench and two plaques are included in June, though checks have not been cut.
- IV. Ongoing Items
- A. Nora Barton Bryant Memorial Bench The bench has been delivered and assembled. It will be kept in BG's garage until installation. The plaque will be attached with adhesive.
- B. The student-built picnic table has been taken to the Town Beach. Its plaque will also be attached with adhesive.
- C. Open Space The event at the Newfoundland Pony Rescue on May 25 was a success. Buttons and certificates were awarded to young Citizen Conservationists.
- D. Education CDG has heard from Sam Jaffee, the Caterpillar Man, but no event has been scheduled.
- E. CPCA The kiosk is ready to install. The Nutting Rd. kiosk could be re-oriented for better visibility at the same time. CK believes the Nutting Rd. parking area should be scraped and graveled to permit year-round use. Motion: To improve the Nutting Rd. parking area at CPCA by excavating and laying down gravel, at an estimated cost of \$1,200.00. Passed.
