An important message regarding the program’s renewal, supplier, and rates

### What’s Happening?

Your electricity account is enrolled in Jaffrey Community Power, which provides program rates for the supply portion of your Eversource bill.

The Town’s current supply contract ends in November 2025. Starting with the renewal, Direct Energy will be the Town’s new electricity supplier, and new program rates will take effect.

### What This Means for You

- **No Action Needed** – You will remain in your current program option (Basic, Default, 50%, or 100%). Your selected option will continue automatically at the new rate.
- **Switch Options Anytime** – You may choose a different program option, including greener renewable options.
- **Opt Out Anytime** – Participation is voluntary, you may leave the program at no cost and return to Eversource’s Default Service.

### How Community Power Works

If you participate in the program, here is how your electricity bill from Eversource will be affected:

- The Supplier portion of your bill will reflect your enrollment in Jaffrey Community Power.
- Eversource will continue to provide Delivery Services, respond to outages, and send your electricity bill.
- Customers enrolled in the Electric Assistance Program (EAP) or budget billing will continue receiving those benefits with no changes.

#### Net Metering Customers

- If you receive credits from solar panels or other net metering, you may not receive your full credits under the program. For NEM 2 customers, supply credits are zero for sales that exceed purchases.
