#### Notes on the May 18th, 2023 Meeting at Cutter Cemetery.

The following members met at 4pm at Cutter Cemetery: Charlie Turcotte, Rob Stephenson, Peter Lambert, Cathy Proulx, Jan Weeks along with volunteers Jeannelle Moore and Eric Healy.

Note: This was the 2nd Meeting of the Committee for 2023. All town owned Cemeteries were visited by the Committee in 2022.

Gravestone Restoration of N.E. has repaired eleven of the fifteen tablet type markers in the Village Cemetery. Kai of G.R. of NE reported that three were not repairable due to missing pieces and that one could only be stood up and reset in the ground. (See notes of July 22, 2022) An estimate of \$5,150.00 was submitted. The Jaffrey Gravestone Restoration Fund, as December 31, 2022 has a balance of \$9,959.92.

On June 17th from 12:30 to 1:30 the Cemetery Committee along with the Jaffrey Historical Society will sponsor a Walking Tour in the Old Burying Ground. "Special Veterans Addition Tour" will feature Veterans who are intered within the Old Burying Ground as part of the larger "Salute to Veterans Celebration" which is being held on the Meeting House Grounds from 2:00 to 4:30.

The DPW under the direction of Todd Crouteau will need to clear a tree that is across the path of the trail to the Small Pox Cemetery. (As reported last month). Charlie has contacted Todd to remind him of the issue. He was also reminded that the Village Cemetery's winter tree debris has not been cleaned up.

At Cutter Extension there is also a large Ash Tree along the east wall that needs to be removed. Rob pointed out the need to replace a few of the Elm Trees that have been planted over the past several years and have died.

Peter mentioned that a work session at Phillips/Heil would be appropriate as there are some tablets in need of straightening.

The "Cemetery Flag Placement" took place on May 20 starting at 9:00am. Members of the Cemetery Committee, VFW, American Legion and volunteers placed over 860 flags into the Veteran Medallions in all of Jaffrey's Cemeteries.

The committee toured Cutter and Cutter Extenion Cemetery. On the walk thru Cutter we discovered one foot marker which was dislodged from its base.
