Public Information and Input Session - Carey Road & Sherwin Hill Road – Conversion from Class VI Road to Class A or B Trail

Both Carey Road and Sherwin Hill Road are currently Class VI roads. The intent is to reclassify them to preserve the integrity of the roadways and limit vehicular traffic. Carey Road would be reclassified as a Class B Trail with bars installed to prohibit vehicles. There is a great deal of foot traffic into Children's Woods and reclassification would be safer for pedestrians and the trail would be able to be maintained. Sherwin Hill Road would be reclassified as a Class A trail, allowing agricultural and forestry access. The Town would have access to the well field in order to do maintenance. Both roads would have locked gates with signage. Carolyn Garretson from the Conservation Commission was present and stated that the Commission fully supports both these projects and they funded the gates and trail signage for Carey Road. Chairman Sterling noted that the Board also supports these projects and both will be on the Town Meeting warrant.
