<u>2023 Water & Sewer Rates</u> – Annual reassessment of water and sewer rates. A 5% increase on water and sewer is projected to maintain an adequate fund balance. The 2023 water rate would be \$1.46/100 gallons, a .7 increase. The sewer rate would be \$2.16/100 gallon. The total estimated impact per household is roughly \$6/month for both.

On a motion by Belletete, seconded by Chamberlain to approve the 2023 water rate of 1.46/100 gallon and the 2023 sewer rate of 2.16/100 gallon.

<u>Sewer Debt Payoff</u> - \$150,000 was allocated in the 2022 budget that has not been utilized, these funds could be used to pay off two sewer debts early. Sterling suggested paying off Debt 2: River Street/Nelson Circle and leave Debt 1: Sewer Facility Upgrade in place.

On a motion by Belletete, seconded by Chamberlain to pay off sewer Debt 2: River Street/Nelson Circle was approved (3-0).

<u>Resolution #2022-1</u> - Special Event Permit - Wreaths Across America - American Legion - Dec. 12, 2022 – no objections from Town staff.

On a motion by Belletete, seconded by Chamberlain, Resolution #2022-1 was approved (3-0).

<u>Meetinghouse Tower Project Funds Transfer</u> – The project is complete, only \$13,000 was received in donations. Requesting \$6,500 from Meeting House Fund, \$2,000, from Town Clock Fund and \$90,941.29 from the Municipal Building Maintenance CRF.

On a motion by Belletete, seconded by Chamberlain to withdraw \$6,500 from Meeting House Fund, \$2,000, from Town Clock Fund and \$90,941.29 from the Municipal Building Maintenance CRF was approved (3-0).
