C. Appointments – 2024 Dog License Fees – Kelly Rollins, Town Clerk

Town Clerk Rollins came before the Board to request an addition of \$1.00 to the dog licensing fees. This would generate \$800 in revenue for the Town. In researching, Jaffrey was low in their charges compared to surrounding towns. There is a fine for late registrations and non-compliance that can also be collected.

This request is only for dog licenses, not car registrations.

D. Public Hearings – Acceptance of NH State Block Grant Aid for Maintenance, Construction, and Reconstruction of Class IV and V Highways in the amount of \$45,291.79

Chairman Sterling opened the Public Hearing at 6:05pm

TM Frederick explained that this funding is allocated for maintenance, construction and reconstruction of Class IV and V highways and would be added to the paving fund to be expended in 2024. Turcotte asked if sidewalks could also be included, however, TM Frederick stated that sidewalks are not considered "roads", they are their own entity.

Seeing that there were no public comments/questions, Chairman Sterling closed the Public Hearing at 6:07pm.

DRA Sales Ratio Survey Certification

Per our Assessor, the draft analysis of the house sales in 2023 indicates the median ratio to be 57.6%, which is a 9% change from last year. Many houses are being sold for way more than their assessed value. Unfortunately, the re-evaluation isn't until 2025, which will bring the numbers back to a more consistent/accurate level.

Sterling- HDC will be meeting the 2nd Thursday of December.

Planning Board – They had a site walk up on Rte. 124 to view a proposed driveway for a new subdivision. The State will have the final say, since 124 is a State road. No decisions were made.

<u>Chamberlain</u> – Concom met. The management plan for NEWT needs to be drafted by the Concom within 12 months of the easement. The Natural Resource Inventory is continuing. Late January/February should be when it should be able to be presented to the Town Boards, which will be great for understanding the geological makeup of the town. They also discussed the driveway on Route 124.

<u>Turcotte</u> – Cemetery Committee doesn't meet until April. Budcom met and all is well with the budget.
