






Draw a cardinal on paper, similar to left photo.

Make one or two wings.


Color in bird and wings.

Glue on, or draw in eye.

Glue on or use brad to
attach wings to back so your
cardinal can fly.



Attach string to center of back and make loop at other end to hang up your cardinal.
