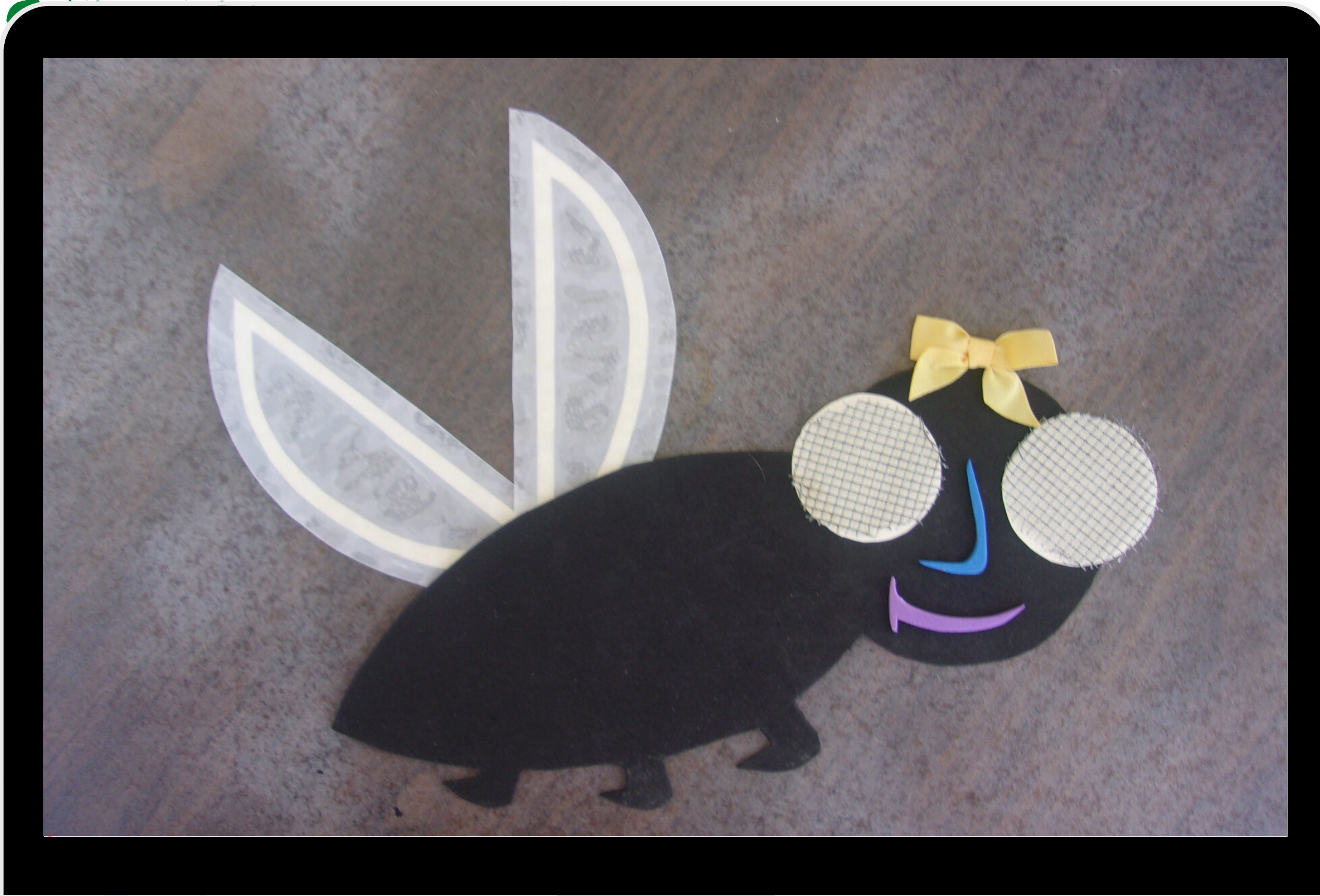




## Ms. Linda's Take & Make: Super Fly



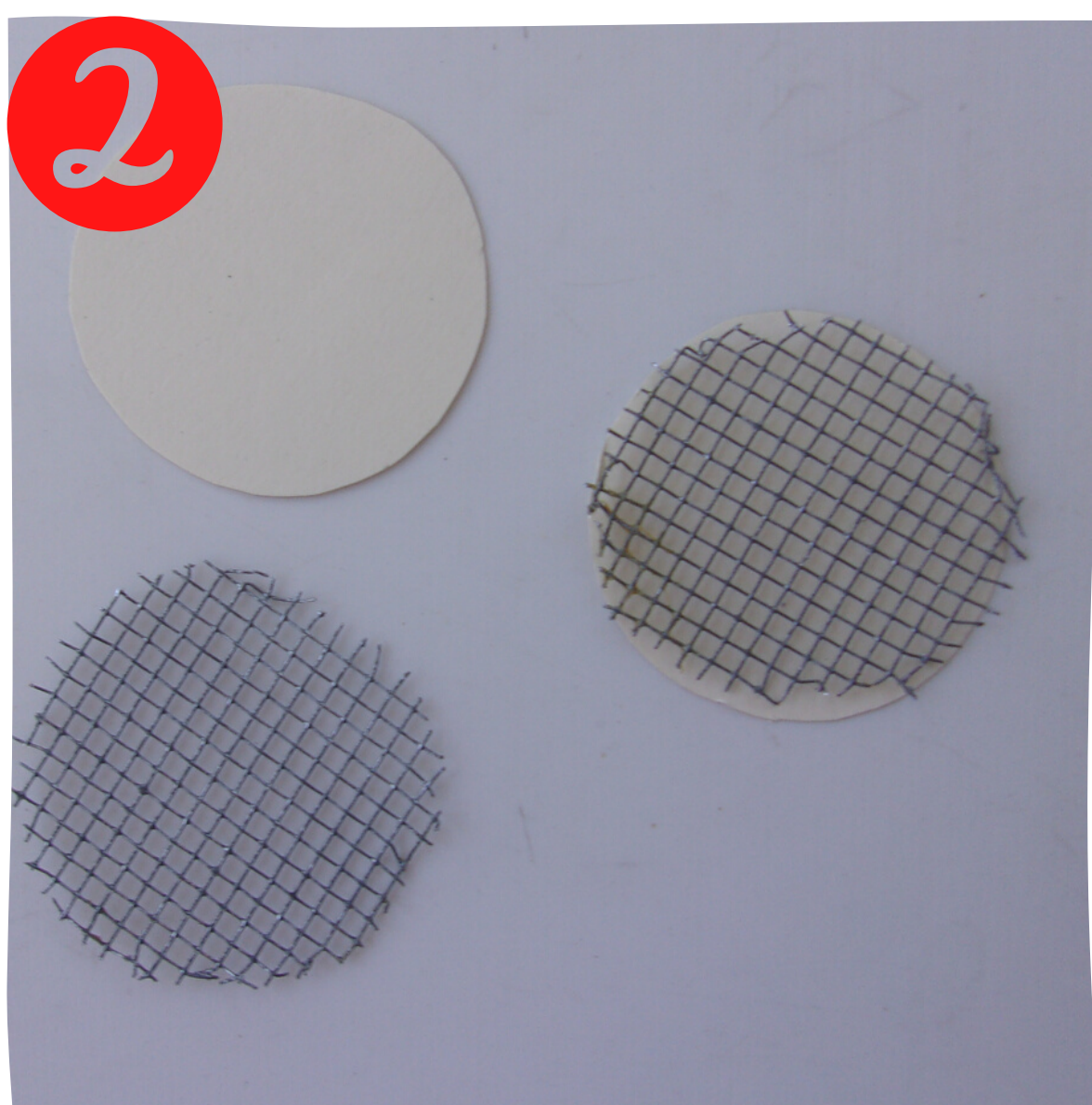

### Materials Needed:

- Sheet of black foam or black construction paper
- Light colored construction paper
- Wax paper
- Mesh/screen, cutters
- Foam, or colored paper for nose and mouth
- Marker



Look at picture to left and cut out similar fly body shape from black foam or construction paper.



Cut out large eyes from light colored paper.  
Cover eyes with mesh or screen, glue. Or you could draw in screen lines with marker.



Cut out similar shape wings from wax paper.  
Use light colored paper inserts to give them strength.  
You can ask for help to iron them together or glue them together yourself.



Attach wings and eyes to body with glue.

To decorate face glue bow, nose, and mouth in place.

Show off your fly!
