



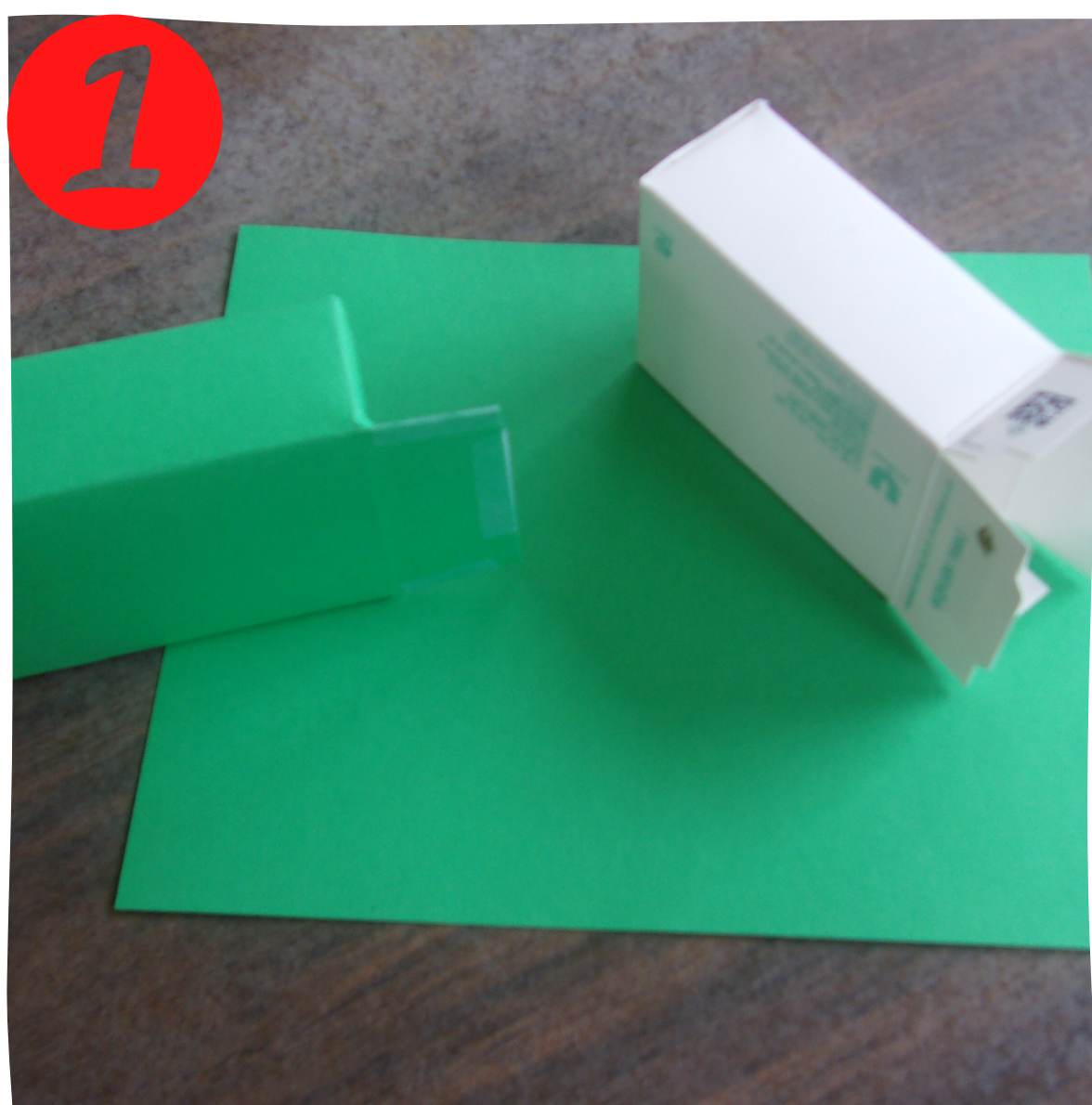
# Ms. Linda's Take & Make: Croaky the Frog



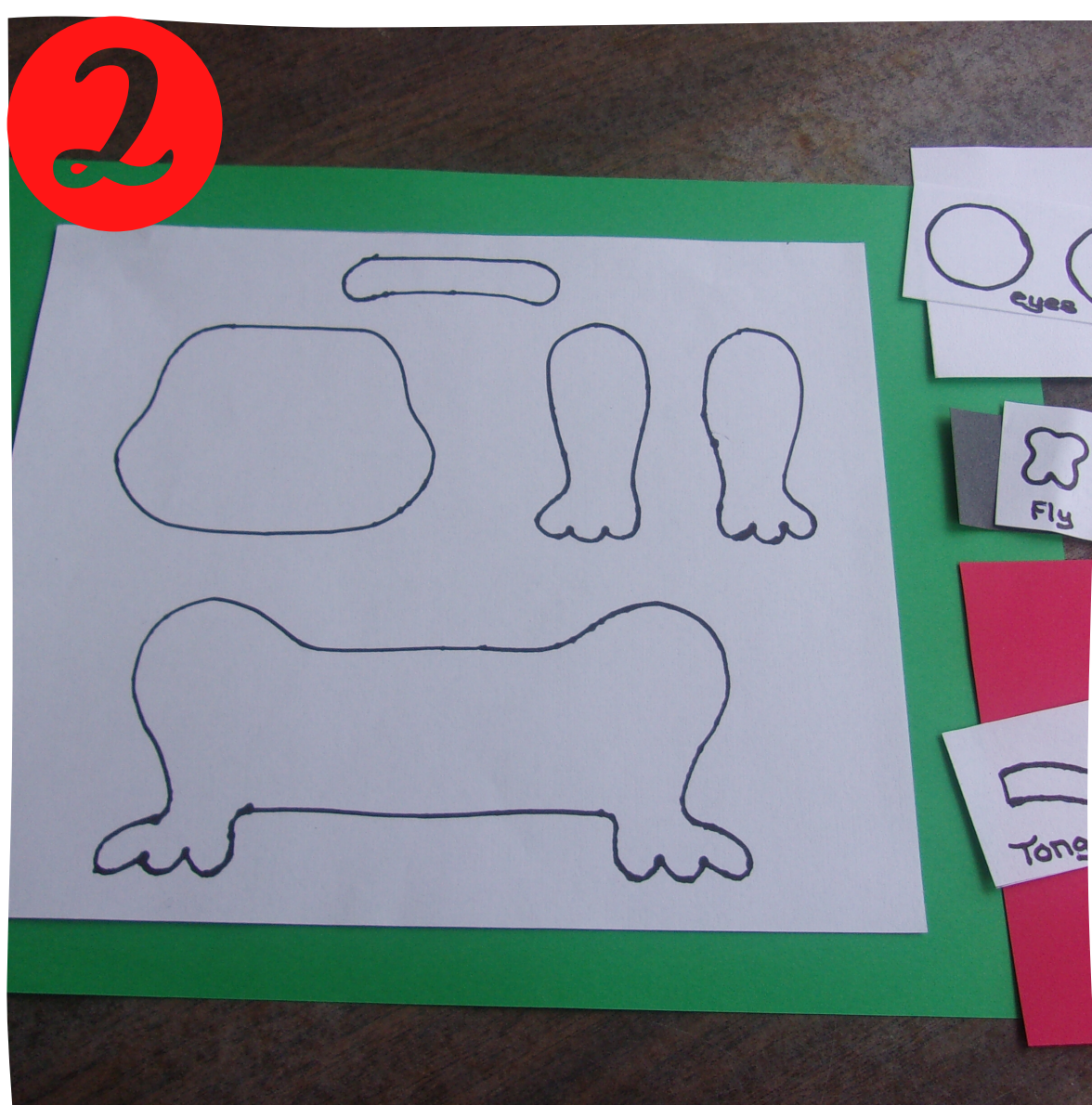
Visit [TumbleBooks](#) on the library catalog and search "Where Is Croaky?" by Eva-Marie Welsh to read this week's Take & Make picturebook. Then continue to the next page for instructions on making Ms. Linda's craft.

## Materials Needed:

- Soap size box
- Construction paper
- Marker



Wrap box in green paper, leaving 1/2 the box top "flap" open to tape the head onto later.



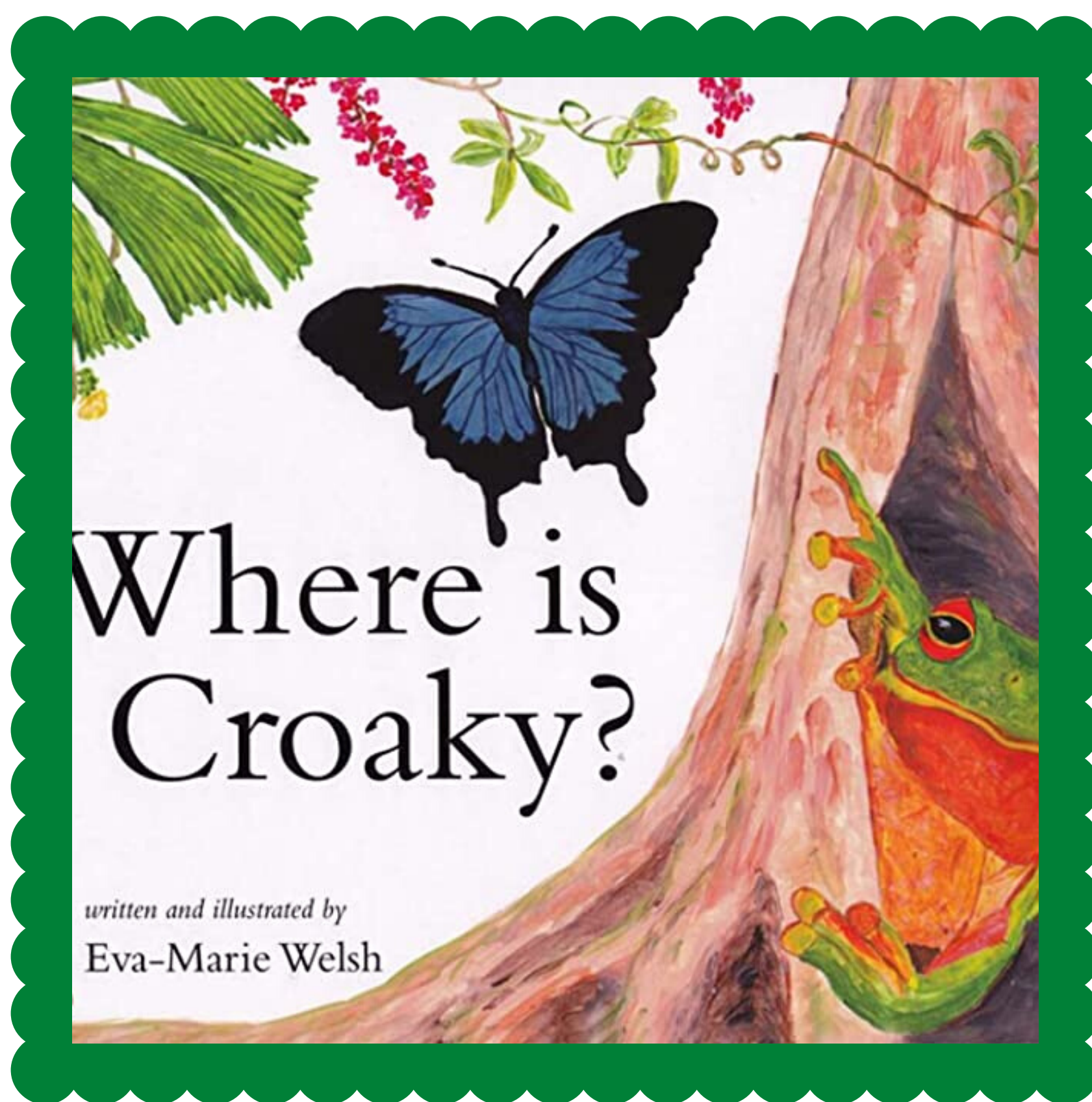
Look at the paper "sample" sheet left and copy/draw up similar head, legs, and mouth.  
Draw eyes, tongue, and fly out of different color paper.



Cut out frog pieces.  
Tape rear legs to lower back keeping toes even with the bottom of the box.  
Tape front legs onto the lower corner sides of frog.



Tape head onto the front top extended flap of box.  
Glue on eyes, mouth, tongue, and fly.  
Using marker dot nose.  
Play hide & seek with your frog.  
Rib-bet, rib-bet!
