

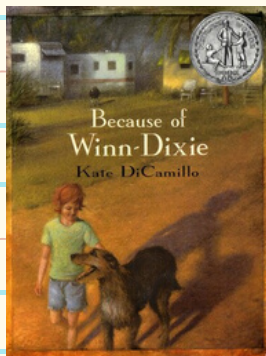


# Egg Salad

# Egg Salad

Serves: 4

Total time: 25 minutes



## Ingredients

- 6 large eggs
- 1/4 cup mayonnaise
- 1 Tbs. mustard
- salt and pepper

## Directions

Place eggs in a pot and add enough water to cover eggs by at least one inch. Quickly bring the water to a boil, then remove from heat and let the eggs sit in the hot water for 15 minutes. Remove eggs from hot water and immediately place them in a bowl filled with ice until they're cooled completely.

Peel the cooled eggs and dice or mash them. Mix together mayonnaise and mustard; combine with the eggs. Add salt and pepper to taste. Refrigerate for at least an hour to allow the flavors to combine.
