



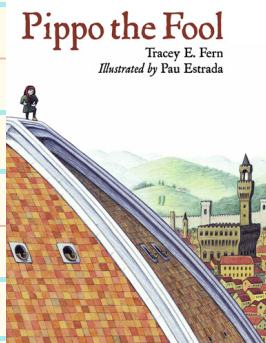
# Spaghetti Sauce

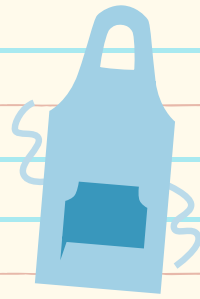
## Spaghetti Sauce

### Ingredients

- 15 oz. can diced tomatoes
- 15 oz. can tomato sauce
- 6 oz. can tomato paste
- 2 Tbs. sugar (adjust to taste)
- 1/2 tsp. basil
- 1/2 tsp. oregano
- 1/2 tsp. black pepper
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1 tsp. crushed red pepper flakes (adjust to taste)

### Directions

Throw it all in a sauce pan, stir, simmer, cover and continue to simmer for 20-30 minutes.

Season again to taste. Enjoy!
