
Artist Afternoon To-Go

Step 1.

Cut out random shapes from your colored paper until you have a good amount - you can always cut more later, as well.







Lay out your pieces in a fun and interesting way.

Step 3.

Glue the pieces down where you put them, working from the pieces underneath to the pieces on top.

Gluing Tips

Before gluing down, take a picture of your work to remember where you put the paper pieces.

Use a paintbrush to spread the glue so it goes on evenly and does not create any bumps.

Step 4.

Glue the pieces down where you put them, working from the pieces underneath to the pieces on top.
