Step 1.

Rip three or four pieces of construction paper to create your mountains. Don't rip the blue paper, you'll need the full sheet for Step 2. Don't forget to make some clouds out of white!





Step 2.

Arrange the ripped pieces on your blue paper to create mountains and clouds. Try them out in different orders.

Step 3.


Once you've decided on a pattern, glue the mountains in place. Optional: Decorate your scene by drawing little people, houses, or animals!
