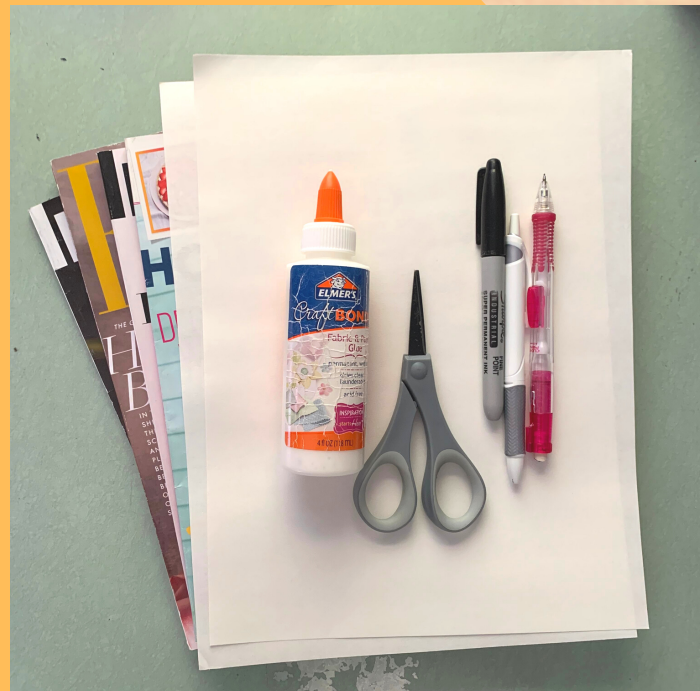

Picasso Collage Portrait

Pablo Picasso was a Spanish artist known for his experimental style and modern art. Materials

- magazines or newspaper
- scissors
- glue
- paper
- markers
- optional: crayons or colored pencils

Step 1.

Gather magazines or newspapers and cut out faces with clear features - eyes, noses, mouths, ears.



Step 2.

Lay the pieces you cut out onto your paper to make a funny face.

Step 3.

Glue the pieces down where you put them.
Tip: Use a paintbrush to spread the glue and make it less bumpy!

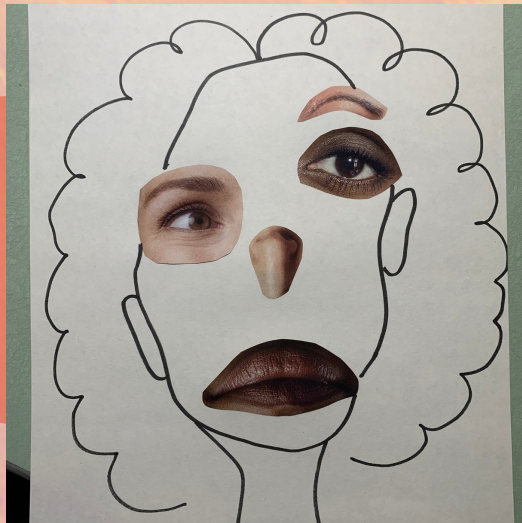


Step 4.

Draw the rest of the face -
it doesn't have to be realistic!

Color in your art with any materials you wish.
Tip: Use crazy colors to make it more colorful!
