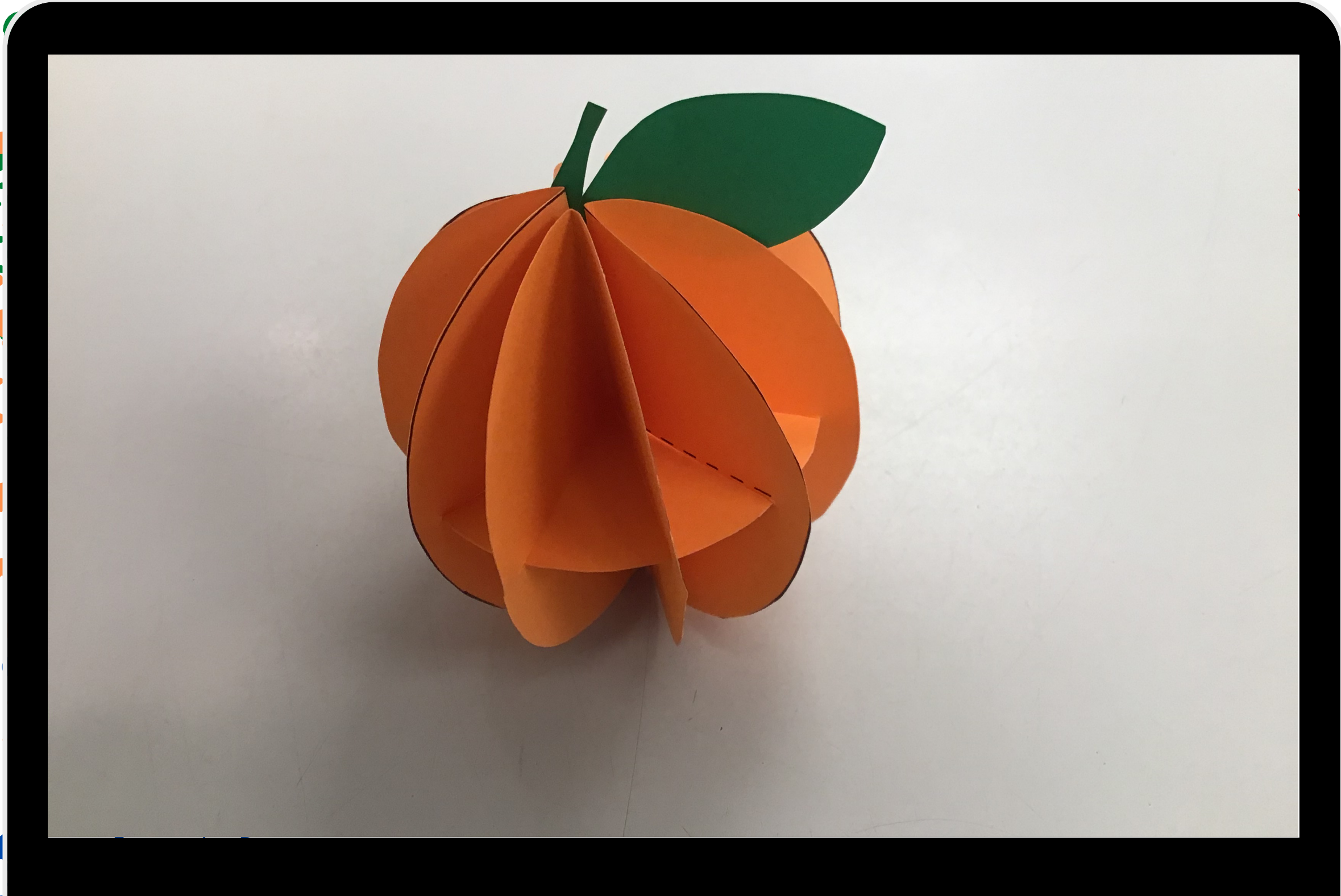




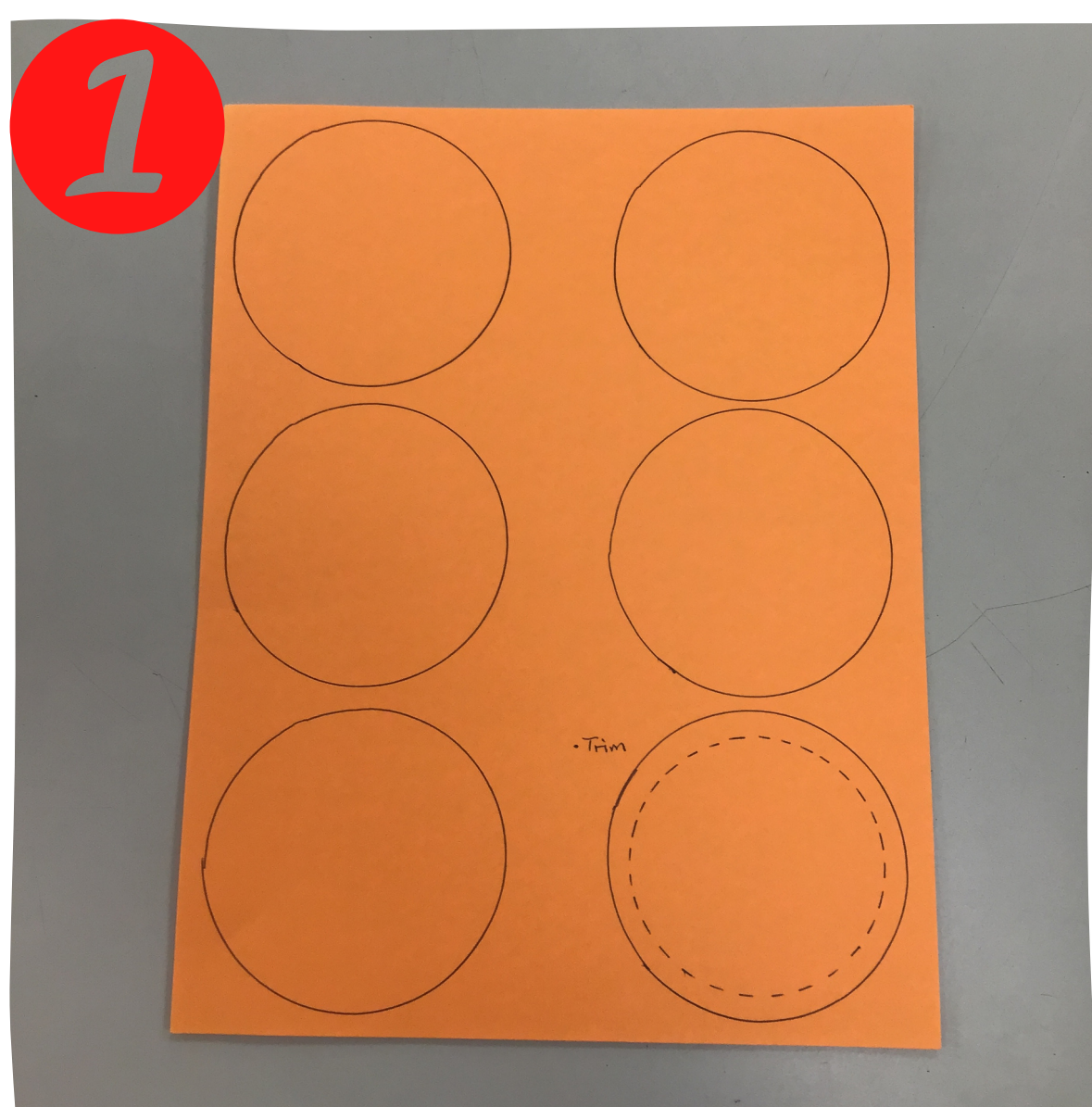
Ms. Linda's Take & Make: Pumpkins



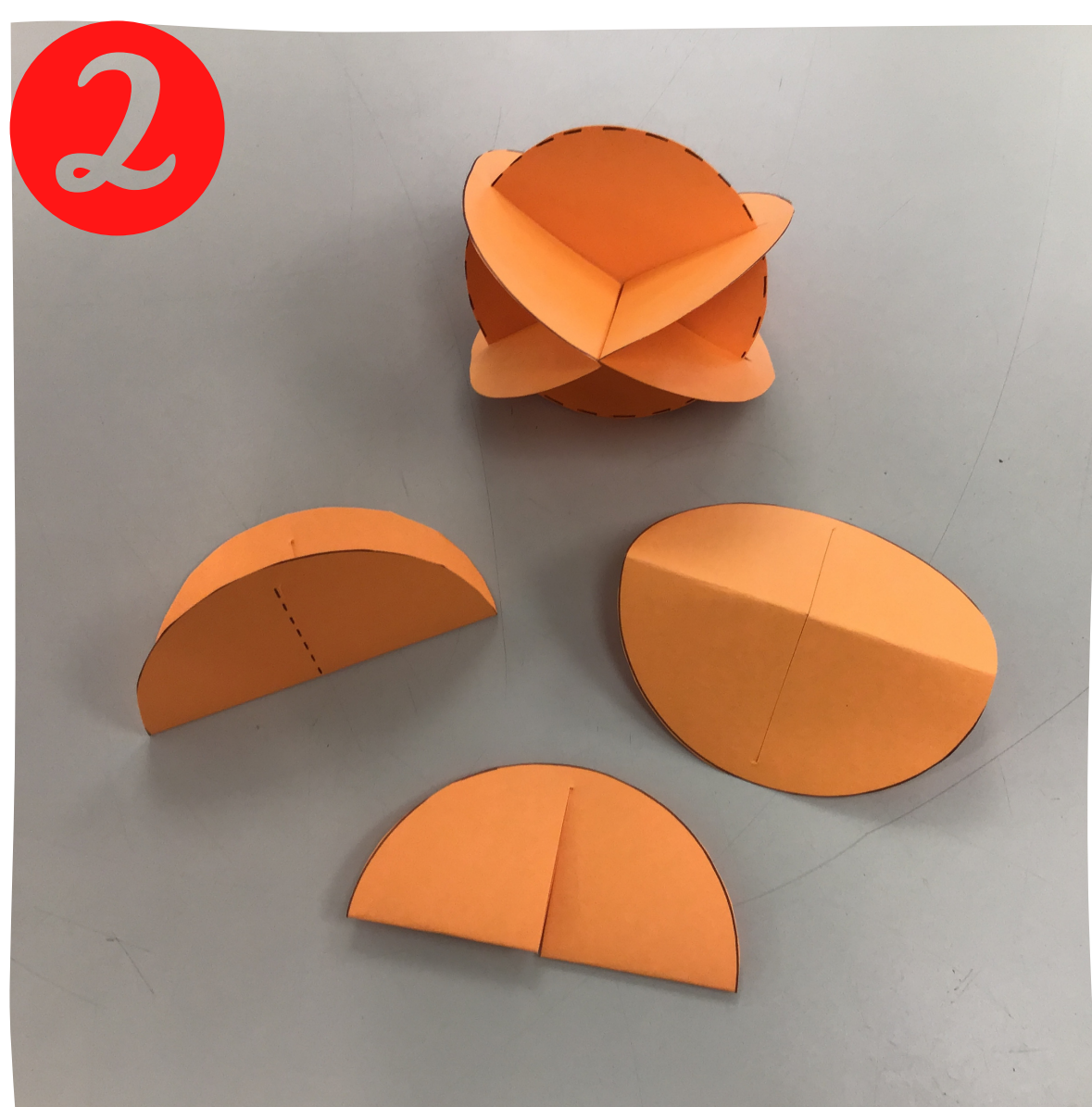

Materials Needed:

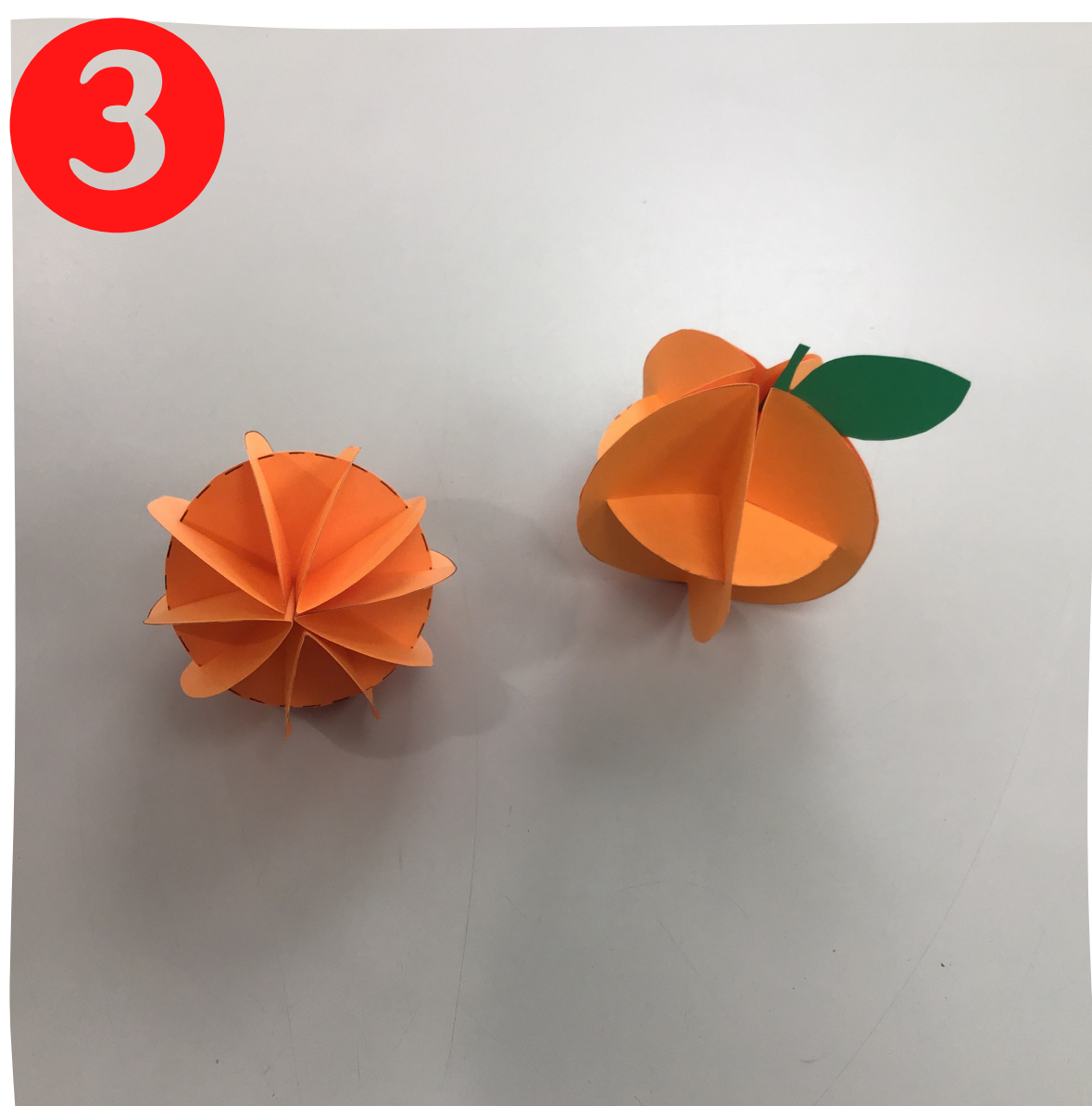
- Orange construction paper
- Scrap green paper
- Scissors, glue stick



Draw six same size circles on orange paper. Cut them out. Trim one to 1/4" smaller than the others and set aside.
*You can put more circles on your pumpkin if you want a fuller look.



Fold the larger circles in half. Cut these from center fold out to 1/4" from circle edge. Holding the smaller circle slide the folded/sliced circles on to it.



Draw and cut out a stem with leaf attached from green scrap paper. Glue this to pumpkin center/top.
*If your sections do not reach to meet at the pumpkin center cut the folded circles a little further towards edge. Your pumpkin is done!
