### Scribble Art

### Materials

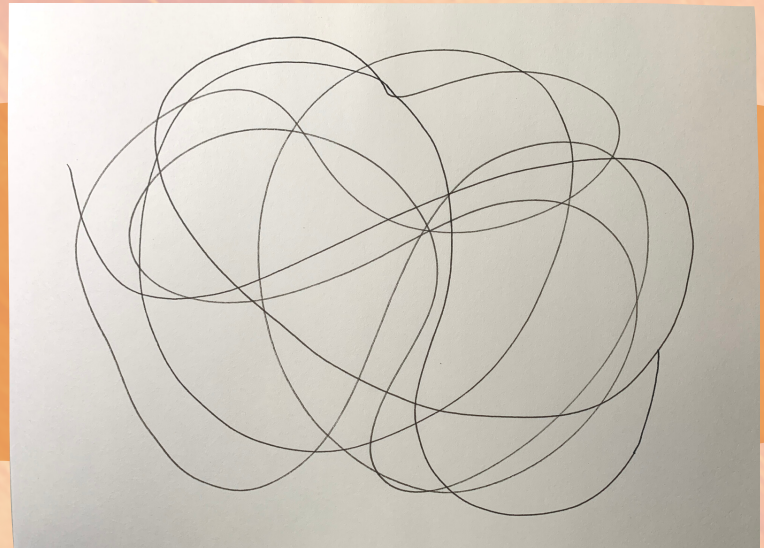
- magazines
- scissors
- black marker
- ruler
- colored paper
- glue

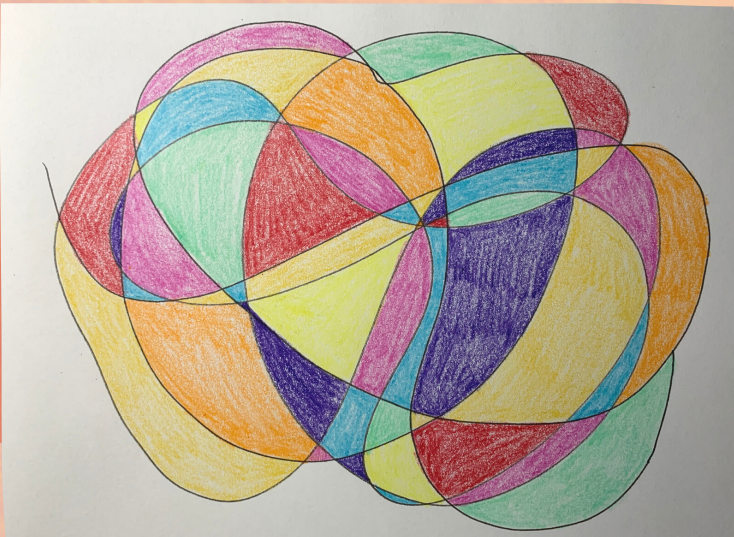
## Step 1.

With your black marker, scribble loosely in circles on your piece of white paper - try to make sections that are big enough to be colored in.



## Step 2.

With as many colors as you want, color in each section. Try to make no two areas next to each other the same color - for example, if one section is colored red, don't color any of the sections around it red.



## Step 3.

Cut out your shape along the outer edge.



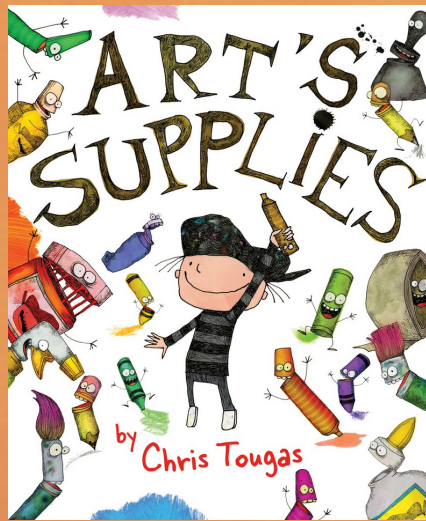
