



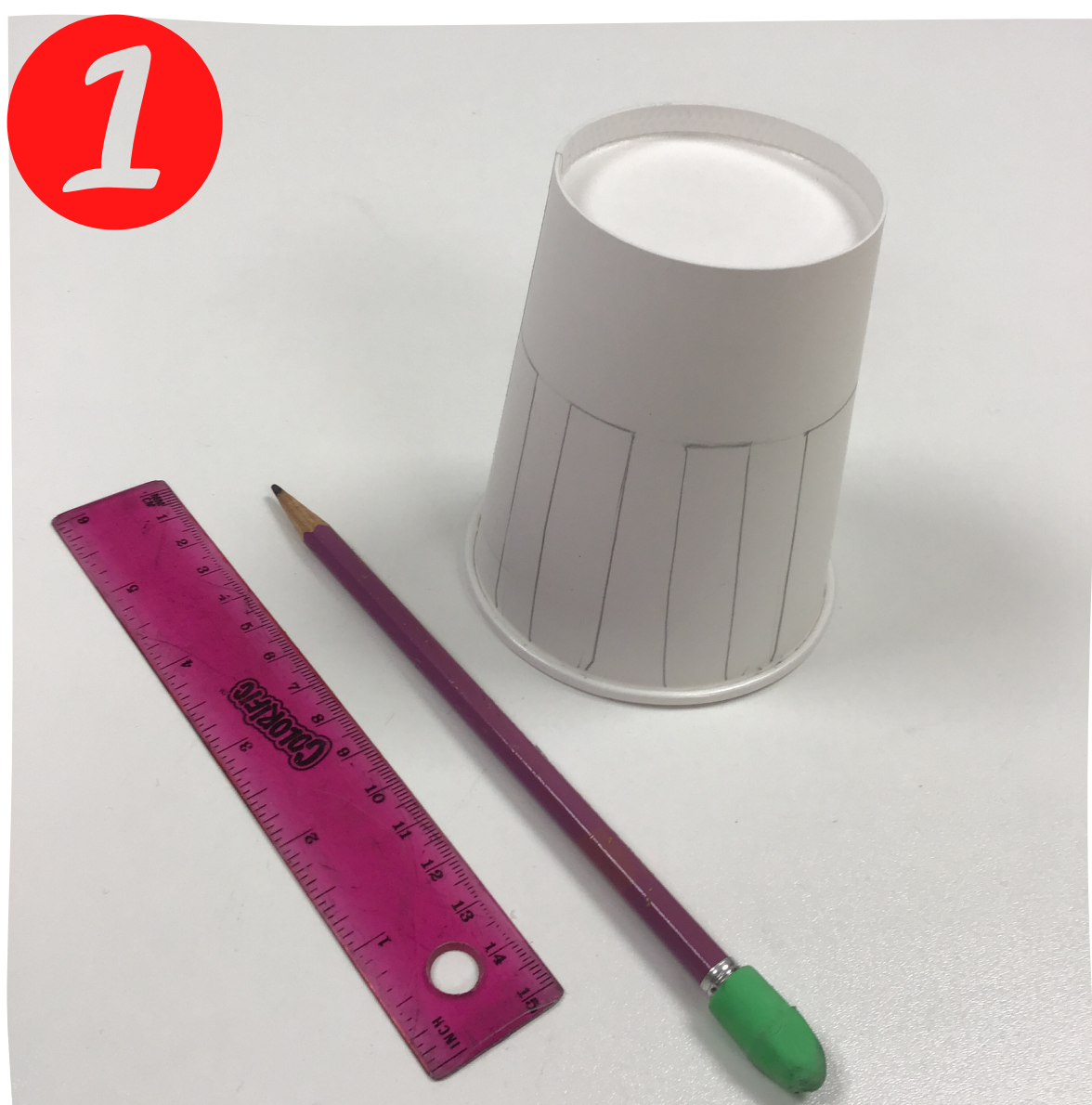
Ms. Linda's Take & Make: Spider



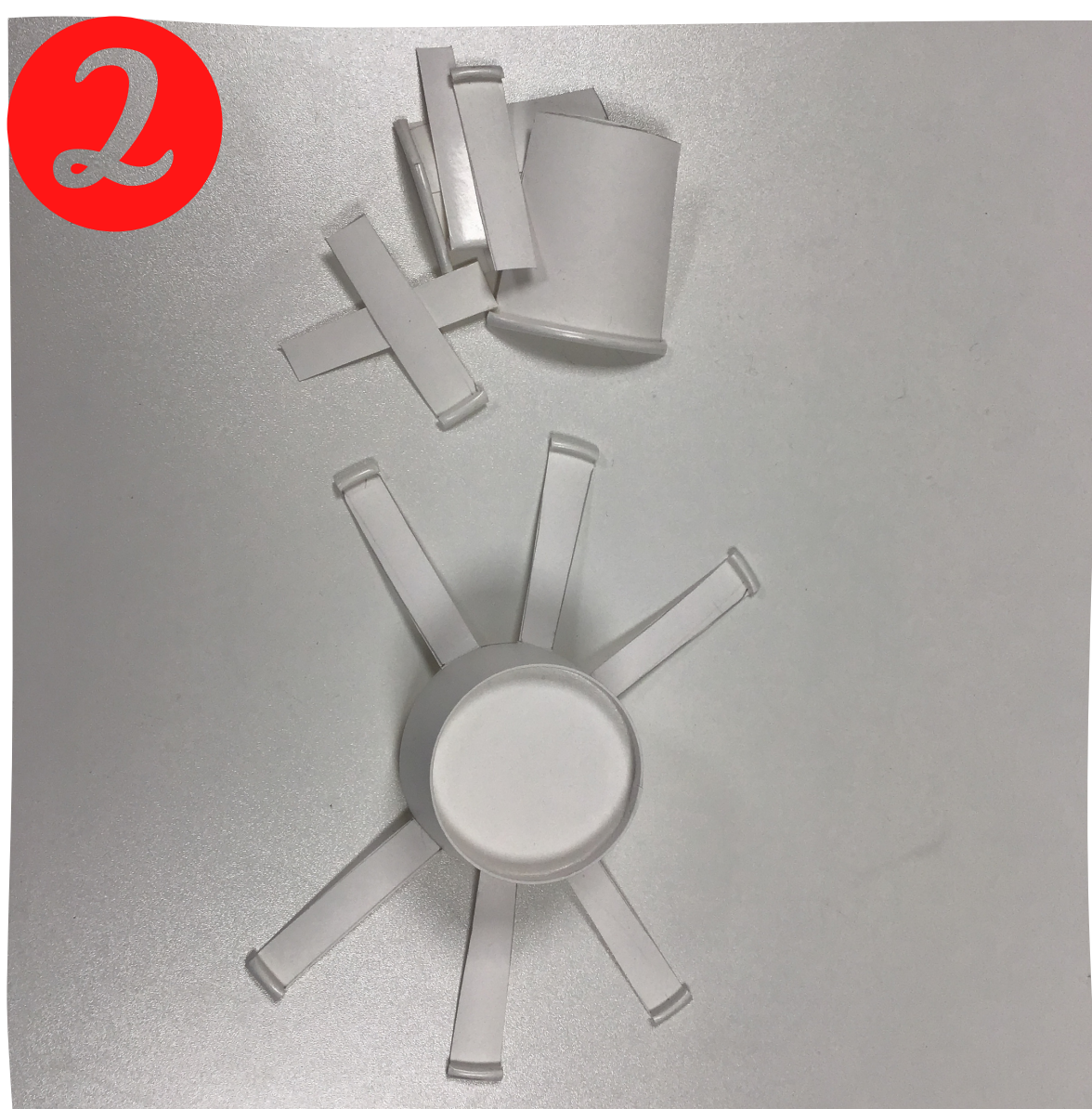

Materials Needed:

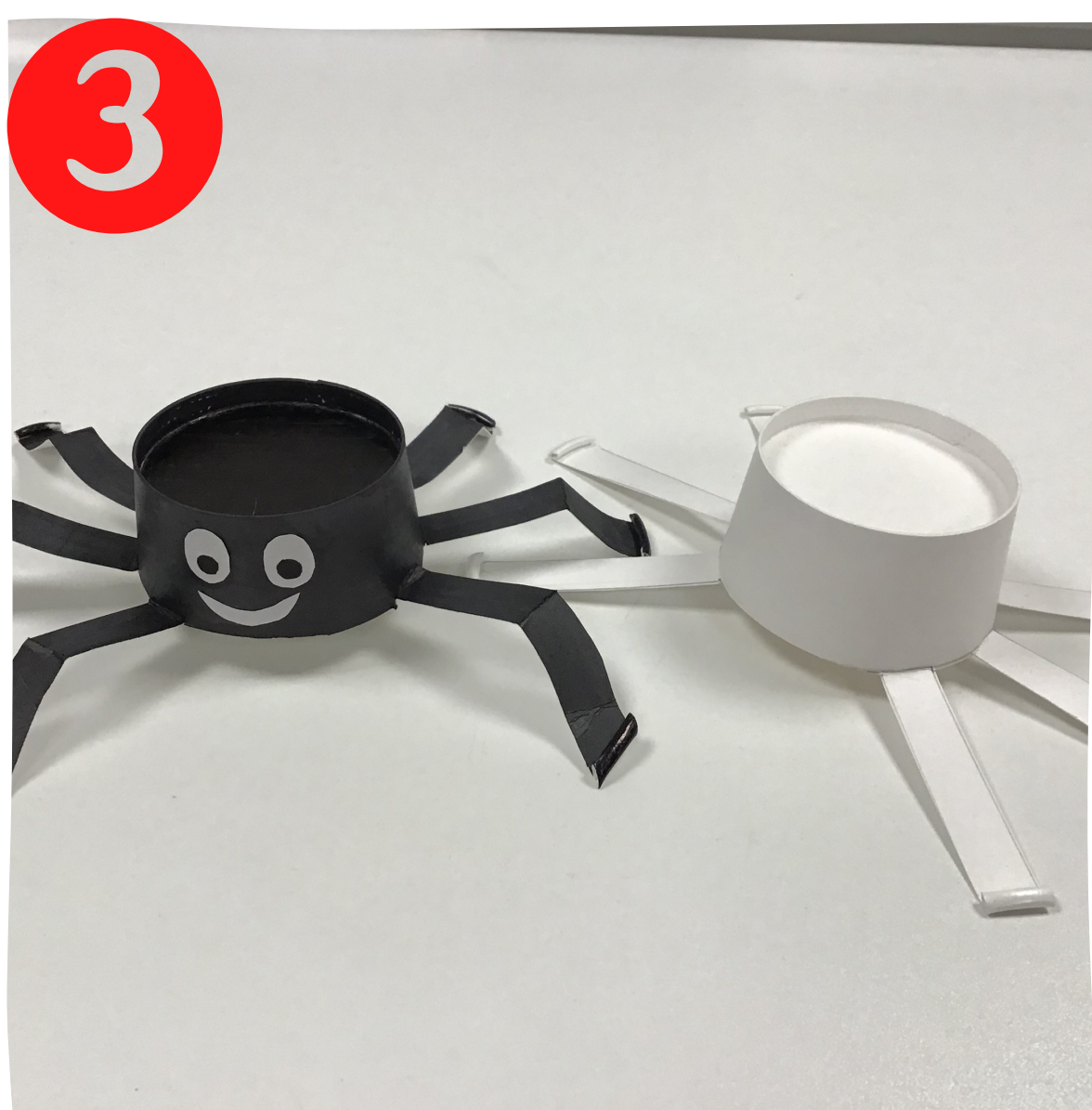
- Paper cup, ruler
- Pencil, scissors
- Black paint/marker or crayon
- Glue stick
- Scrap paper for eyes



Measure down from bottom of cup and draw a line around cup for depth of your spider. On opposite sides draw three legs from this line to rim of cup. (make about 1/4" wide)



Cut up leg lines and remove sections between. Bend legs out flat. Now your spider can sit on a table. Bend legs up in center and at toes if you prefer your spider to walk.



Paint, use marker or crayons to color your spider. Make eyes for him and glue them in place. Give your spider a smile. You can make several spiders and create a show or make a hanging mobile. Have fun!
