

Materials Needed:

- Paper plate
- Construction paper
- Feathers real or you can make your own
- Scissors
- Glue stick or tape


Draw a turtle shell on the paper plate. Draw a turkey head with neck and legs similar to the ones on the left on construction paper. Give your turkey a face.



Color your turkey pieces with crayons.

Cut the turkey pieces out.

Glue or tape the parts together. Head on one side at top, legs at mid body below shell. Make big and little feathers.



Build your turkey around the turtle shell. Place the small feathers at the lower end for a tail. Stick out feathers to form a wing beyond the legs and before the tail similar to the left picture.
