Provide access to competitive markets for supplies of electricity and related energy services


Provide small customers similar opportunities to those available to larger customers, in obtaining lower electric costs, reliable service, and secure energy supplies

## What is Community Power?







Supply

Municipality procures electricity <u>supply</u> for residents and small businesses but does not take ownership of the power

### Delivery

Eversource continues to provide all <u>delivery</u>, emergency, and billing services including the same work crews

## **Jaffrey Community Solar Farm**

ReVision (a local employee-owned B-Corp) is partnering with the Town of Jaffrey on a Community Solar Farm at the Jaffrey Landfill. Jaffrey residents who want to own Solar Farm shares are guaranteed placement if they reserve by April 2024. Ideal for renters, condo owners, and homeowners with old or shaded roofs. Solar credits will appear directly on your monthly home electric bill and owners can take the 30% tax credit while <u>also</u> <u>participating in Community Power</u>.

### **Community Solar Farm Basics:**

**1.4 megawatts**: ReVision's first residential CSF in NH will also be the largest in the state, with enough energy to offset the annual needs of **over 200 families**.

ReVision will start construction on the array this summer and expect it to be **delivering clean solar energy to the grid** - and bill credits to customers - in 2025.

**Eversource NH utility customer** can purchase a share in this CSF.
