## ARTICLES

**Article 2:** Shall the School District vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,877,028 for the construction and installation of energy savings equipment, including but not limited to, a biomass and backup propane boilers at Jaffrey-Rindge Middle School and Conant High School and propane boilers at Jaffrey Grade School and Rindge Memorial School and for the improvement and renovation of insulation, the heating systems and other necessary facilities at the District's schools to be offset by \$196,000 in rebates and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$2,681,028 in bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) for this purpose; and further, to authorize the School Board to issue, negotiate, sell and deliver such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest and the maturity and other terms thereon; to authorize the School Board to apply for, accept, and expend federal, state or other aid and grants available for the project and to comply with all laws applicable to said project; and to raise and appropriate the additional sum of \$67,026 for the first payment on the bond; and to authorize the School Board to take any other action or vote necessary to carry out this vote?

**Article 3:** Shall the school district vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the First Session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$25,397,600? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$ 25,999,574 which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the school district or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of the revised operating budget only.

The committee will be comprised of eight (8) members; one selectman from each town selected by the Board of Selectman of that town, one school board member from each town selected by school board from that town, one planning board member from each town selected by the planning board from that town, one budget committee member from Jaffrey selected by the Jaffrey budget committee and one budget advisory committee member from Rindge selected by the Rindge budget advisory committee.
